CHRISTMAS SAFETY REMINDERS

Follow these simple safety tips for a happy, healthy and safe holiday season for your family:

- Do not leave candles unattended
- Check your Christmas lights for ware
- Keep your tree fresh –add water daily
- Use a designated non-drinking driver
- Have your chimney professionally cleaned
- Review fire escape plans
- Use a carbon monoxide alarm
- Test your fire and smoke detectors
- Recycle wrapping paper—don't burn it
- Recycle your tree at a local recycling center
- Check extension cords for ware
- Position tree at least 3 feet from heat sources
- Decorate with only flame-retardant materials
- Use space heaters with caution
- Do not cook in loose-fitting clothing
- Wear your seat belts!
