8:00 Program FIRE SEASON IS COMING! The lack of rain and the dry brush in our hills makes for a dangerous situation. The Freeway Complex Fire of a few years ago threatened homes in Diamond Bar, and Rowland Heights residents were lucky it did not jump the 57 Freeway to burn our portion of the Puente Hills.

Last year Hills for Everyone released a study of fires in the local hills over the last 100 years. Using data on fires collected from numerous fire agencies they identified hot spots where fires frequently start.
